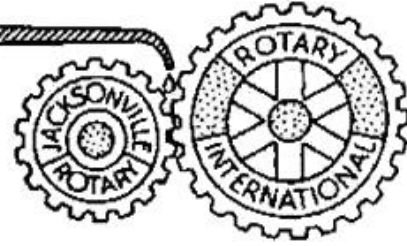

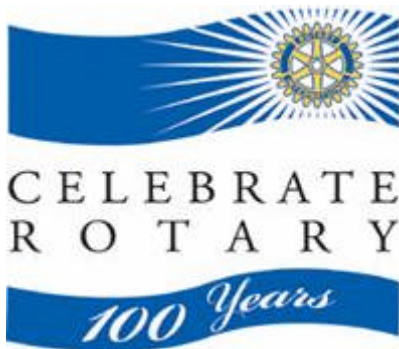
BASS TOURNAMENT SWEATSHIRTS
